



& Main Idea (Objective):





& Arabs spread Islam through teaching, conquest and trade.

Lecture Focus (Essential Question) :



№ When you come up with a new idea, how do you let others know about it? Let look and see how the Arabs were able to spread the religion of Islam throughout the Middle East.

& Muhammad died in 632 C.E. and conflicts began in the Muslim community over who should be the **Caliph**.



Caliph: is the successor to the Messenger of God, who was Muhammad originally.

& A powerful group of Muslim leaders chose the new leader, but disagreements continued.

& The first four Caliphs were Abu Bakr, Umar, Uthman and Ali.



& Each ruled from Madinah and each of these new Caliphs had a personal connection with Muhammad.



ℵ By the year 661 C.E., when the fourth Caliph died, the Arab Empire had expanded to include, Persia, Southwest Asia and Egypt.

& From Syria Muslims soon entered India and Afghanistan.





& The Umayyad's also began to explore the African Coast.



& They also crossed the Mediterranean Sea into Spain, where the built and advanced Muslim state there.

▶ Just one hundred years after Muhammad's death, the Islamic state became a vast and great empire.

ℵ They were essentially fighting to spread Islam.



& Muslims believed anyone who died in battle, fighting for Islam, would be granted acceptance into Heaven.

▶ The Arabs were also extremely successful because they usually let conquered peoples practice their own religions.



▶ The fact that they accepted other peoples faiths showed that they were understanding and open-minded.



& Muslims referred to Christians, Jews and Zoroastrains (Monotheistic Iranian religion) "People of the Book," meaning that these people, too, believed in one God and had holy writings.




& Muslims did however charge any Non-Muslims a special religious tax.



▶ In the Arab Empire, many people became Muslim and learned Arabic as a language and religion.

& They set up trading post throughout southeast Asia and taught Islam to the people in these areas.



& Today, the country of Indonesia includes more Muslims than any other nation in the world.








& Some Muslim merchants crossed the Sahara desert to trade within the Western African kingdoms.
